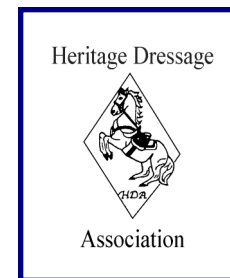
**Training Level Tests may be ridden in a small or large arena subject to scheduling demands.*
